Continuing Education

- All Jones Institute courses are 20 hours of continuing education.
- Jones Institute does not allow partial attendance at any course. No partial certificates are issued. A registrant must attend the full 20 hours of the course to receive a completion certificate for that course. – No exceptions.
- Jones Institute applies for CEU approval with all states that require the educational provider to get pre-approval before the course begins. We do not apply with state boards that do not require the provider to have pre-approval.
- Should the above apply Jones Institutes' CEU application is only submitted to the state board in the state where the course is held. If you are attending and hold your license outside of the state where the course is held, please check with your state licensing board for their CEU requirements on courses out of state.

Upon approval from the state board CEU approval information will be printed on the bottom of each completion certificate.

- Jones Institute has been teaching across the U.S. for over 20 years and has always been given CEU approval for all of our courses. We have never had a denial for CEU credit.
- A Jones Institute course completion certificate may be filed by the therapist with any state board for CEU credit however, if you are attending and hold your license outside of the state where the course is held, please check with your state licensing board for their CEU requirements on courses out of state.

There are one page course outlines with schedules found on the home page for your convenience in filing with a state board.

- The Jones Institute Certification Test does not qualify for CEU's. It is a test.
